ELIGIBILITY

V

A child must be three years old by September I of the school year and toilet trained to be eligible for the three-year-old program.

A child must be four years old by September I of the school year, or planning to enter kindergarten the following year, to be eligible for the four/five-year-old program.

Each child is required to have a physical examination, with a health certificate turned in to the school at least one week prior to the beginning of the school year, in compliance with state licensing guidelines.
